2017 Grant Application Guidelines

PURPOSE:

The Tillotson Coaticook Region Fund was established to support broad charitable purposes in Coaticook and surrounding communities. The Fund intends to further its purposes by awarding financial assistance grants, including in the following areas:

- Basic needs and community safety net
- Health care
- Education
- Youth recreation
- Programs and services for the Elderly

GRANT ELIGIBILITY:

The Fund will accept grant applications for up to \$10,000 from Canadian organizations serving Coaticook and surrounding communities, including nonprofits, registered charities, municipalities and others.

The following activities are generally **not eligible for support**:

- Conferences
- Construction
- Cultural
- Advertising and marketing
- Salaries
- Grants to individuals
- Tourist
- Religious programs (faith-based organizations may apply for non-religious programs)

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- March 8, 2017 (grants awarded April 26)
