## MAKING THE MOST OF RECYCLING

### MATERIALS ACCEPTED IN RECYCLING BINS

Place these materials directly in your bin without using plastic bags.

#### PAPER AND CARDBOARD

Remove flyers and newspapers from your *Publi-Sac*. Avoid recycling paper or cardboard soiled with oil or grease.

- Writing paper, envelopes, books
- Newspapers, flyers and magazines
- Brown paper and bags
- Corrugated and flat cardboard boxes
- Foil-lined juice cartons
- Milk and juice cartons



**WARNING!** Bag all shredded paper in a clear bag and tie.

#### METAL

Metal containers should be rinsed.

- Aluminum cans
- Clean aluminum plates and foil
- Metal covers



**WARNING!** Batteries, car batteries, aerosol cans, electrical wires, clotheslines, metal clothes hangers, wiring and mesh, and all objects 2 kg or more must be taken to an ecocentre.

#### RIGID PLASTIC

Rigid plastic containers should be rinsed. Save space in your bin by crushing larger items.

- All plastic items featuring the following logos:
- Food, household and cosmetic containers
- Plastic toys without metal parts



**WARNING!** Styrofoam items (even those with the  logo), vinyl, and garden hoses are not recyclable.

#### FLEXIBLE PLASTIC

Bag all flexible plastic and tie securely.

- Grocery, shopping, milk, bread bags...
- Clean plastic wrap



**WARNING!** Tarps and swimming pool covers are not recyclable.

#### GLASS

Glass containers should be rinsed. Recycle covers separately.

- Jars, vials, bottles with and without labels



**WARNING!** Dishes and drinking glasses are not recyclable.
