### PURPOSE:

**The Tillotson Coaticook Region Fund was established to support broad charitable purposes in Coaticook and surrounding communities.** The Fund intends to further its purposes by awarding financial assistance grants, including in the following areas:

- Basic needs and community safety net
- Health care
- Education
- Youth recreation
- Programs and services for the Elderly

### GRANT ELIGIBILITY:

The Fund will accept grant applications for up to \$10,000 from Canadian organizations serving Coaticook and surrounding communities, including nonprofits, registered charities, municipalities and others.

The following activities are generally **not eligible for support**:

- Conferences
- Construction
- Cultural
- Advertising and marketing
- Salaries
- Grants to individuals
- Tourist
- Religious programs (faith-based organizations may apply for non-religious programs)
